Fall Burlap Topiary



Create this Fall Burlap Topiary to bring the fall season into your home with autumn décor. The natural burlap ribbon in a variety of colors makes this a festive harvest craft.

Step-by-Step Instructions

YOU WILL NEED

- 7 yd. each of 1 ½" Offray Burlap, Wired Edge in Orange, Apple, Natural, Yellow and Russet
- 7 yd. each of 2 ½" Offray Burlap, Wired Edge in Orange, Apple, Natural, Yellow and Russet
- 8 yd. of 2 ½" Offray Burlap, Wired Edge in Apple
- 6-inches of Offray Burlap, Wired Edge in Natural
- 1 Double Ball Topiary
- 6" Clay Pot
- 52 Upholstery Tacks
- Glue Gun and Glue
- Scissors
- Wire

- STEP 1** Cut 68 1 ½" X 1 ½" squares of Burlap in each color: Orange, Apple, Natural, Yellow and Russet.
- STEP 2** Cut 68 2 ½" X 2 ½" squares of Burlap in each color: Orange, Apple, Natural, Yellow and Russet.
- STEP 3** Cut 84 2 ½" X 2 ½" squares of Burlap in Apple.
- STEP 4** Make stacks of 3 alternating colors with the 1 ½" X 1 ½" and 2 ½" X 2 ½" squares. Stick an upholstery tack through the center of each stack.
- STEP 5** Curl up the edges of each square to form a flower.
- STEP 6** Secure each stack to the ball topiary. Place glue on each tack before inserting it into the foam.
- STEP 7** Next, make stacks of two 2 ½" squares of apple burlap, secure with an upholstery tack and secure in to the base of the topiary.
- STEP 8** Place topiary in the clay pot and secure with glue.
- STEP 9** Wrap the 1 ½" natural Burlap around the lip of the clay pot and secure with glue.
- STEP 10** Using the remaining 1 ½" natural Burlap make a bow. Glue the bow to the front of the pot.
- STEP 11** Glue a burlap flower to the center of the bow.
