How to Make a Bridal Garter



Create this bridal garter to toss on your wedding day. Use satin ribbon and tulle and embellish with pretty crystal buttons.

Step-by-Step Instructions

- STEP 1** Cut four pieces of tulle to 2-1/4 inches wide by two yards long.
- STEP 2** Measure around your leg and cut the elastic to fit, leaving a 1/2 inch seam allowance.
- STEP 3** Layer all four pieces of tulle. Using a running stitch, gather the tulle lengthwise. Stitch the gathered tulle to the elastic.
- STEP 4** Seam the ends together.
- STEP 5** Use the satin ribbon to tie tiny bows and stitch them in the center so they hold their shape. Embellish the garter with the bows and buttons.

YOU WILL NEED

- Offray Double Face Satin Ribbon, 3/8 Inch Wide, Light Pink
- Offray Tulle, 6 Inch Wide, Pink
- 3/4 Inch Crystal Rhinestone Buttons
- 1-1/2 Inch Crystal Burst Button
- 1/4 Inch Wide Elastic
- Needle and Coordinating Thread
- Ruler or Measuring Tape
- Scissors
