How to Make a Fawn Ears Headband



Even if you aren't a fan of costumes for Halloween, you can still get into the spirit with this Fawn Ears Headband. You just need some felt and a few Offray ribbon flowers to decorate a simple headband!

Step-by-Step Instructions

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- STEP 1** To begin, make a paper template for the ears and trace it onto the rust felt four times. Cut out all the ears.
 - STEP 2** Lay one ear on the brown felt and trace around the edge to create the tip that is about 1 inch long. Cut out two pieces. Cut a wave along the bottom.
 - STEP 3** Cut out two inner ears and six small tear drops from the tan felt.
 - STEP 4** Glue all the pieces onto two of the ears.
 - STEP 5** Glue the ear backs to the ear fronts, leaving 1/4 inch open on the bottom to glue on the headband.
 - STEP 6** Separate the front and back ears and glue to the headband, wrapping the ends around the headband and securing with glue.
 - STEP 7** Glue the flowers on the front of the ears near the headband to finish.

YOU WILL NEED

- Offray Petite Swirl Ribbon Rose, Cream, 1 Package
- Offray Tricolor Satin Rose with Pearl, Peach, 1 Package
- Headband
- Felt Squares in Rust, Brown, and Tan
- Pencil
- Ruler or Measuring Tape
- Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun and Glue

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
