How to Make a Mason Jar Vase for Wedding Chairs



These mason jar hanging vases are so simple and pretty! Tie them onto the side of your wedding chairs to create a beautiful aisle!

Step-by-Step Instructions



- STEP 1** Cut a 3-1/2 yard piece of ribbon for each mason jar vase you plan to make.
- STEP 2** Position the jar at the center of the ribbon. Tie a knot around the top of the mason jar. Make sure the ribbon is under the lip of the mason jar so it doesn't slip off.
- STEP 3** Tie the ends of the ribbon onto the top of the chair, tie a knot and then tie into a bow. Trim the ends of the ribbon on an angle to the desired length.
- STEP 4** Add water and flowers to the jars!

YOU WILL NEED

- Offray Double Face Satin Ribbon, 1-1/2 Inch Wide, Kiwi
- Mason Jars or other glass jars with a lip at the top
- Measuring Tape
- Scissors
