How to Make a Pumpkin Wreath



These cute and petite Pumpkin Wreaths are easy and quick to make. Customize with a variety of prints and colors and hang them all around the house to get into the Halloween spirit!

Step-by-Step Instructions

YOU WILL NEED

- Offray Double Face Satin Ribbon, New Chartreuse (3/8 and 2-1/4 Inch), Petal Peach (3/8 and 2-1/4 Inch)
- Offray Polka Dot Grosgrain Ribbon, Black, 7/8 Inch Wide
- Offray Monostripe Grosgrain Ribbon, 1-1/2 Inch Wide
- Offray Grosgrain Ribbon, Black and Torrid Orange, 3/8 Inch
- Foam Wreath Ring, 6 Inch
- Cutting Blade
- Foam Core Board, Black
- Printed Pumpkins, 4-5 Inch
- Ruler or Measuring Tape
- Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun and Glue

- STEP 1** Print your pumpkin design and cut it out, leaving a small (1/4 inch) border of paper around the pumpkin. This will make it easier to cut out with your knife once it's glued onto foam board. Glue the pumpkin onto the black foam board then cut out the pumpkin with your blade.
 - STEP 2** Take the foam ring and start wrapping the polka dot (or stripe) ribbon around the wreath, overlapping the ribbon as you go. Glue down the end once you have covered the ring.
 - STEP 3** Cut a 28 inch length of the wide New Chartreuse ribbon. Tie into a bow and cut the ends at a slight angle. Heat seal the ends. Glue onto the bottom of the wreath.
 - STEP 4** Tuck the pumpkin behind the bow and glue onto the bottom center of the wreath.
 - STEP 5** Cut a piece of 3/8 inch black ribbon to 9 inches. Slip it around the wreath and glue both ends together to create a hanger.
 - STEP 6** Cut a variety of 3/8 inch ribbons to 36 inches long. Hold them together and tie into a bow. Glue the bow to the top of the hanger ribbon.
