# How to Make a Bird Cage Wedding Card Holder

## Step-by-Step Instructions

### YOU WILL NEED

- Offray Double Face Satin Ribbon, 1-1/2 Inch Wide, Blue Stargazer
- Decorative Wire Bird Cage
- Decorative Flowers
- Card Sign (printed from your computer)
- Measuring Tape
- Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun and Glue

**STEP 1** To begin, measure around the bird cage near the middle where you want to place the ribbon. Add two inches and cut the ribbon to that length.

**STEP 2** Wrap the ribbon around the bird cage, with the ends meeting in the back. Glue the ribbon onto the wires in the front and back. Overlap and glue the ends together.

**STEP 3** Glue the card to the front center of the ribbon.

**STEP 4** Cut a yard of ribbon and tie a bow near the top of the bird cage. Trim the ribbon ends on an angle. Glue the flowers to the center of the bow.
