How to Make Burlap Lace Garland



Make this quick and easy garland for railings, doorways, mantles and lampposts! It comes out to 9 feet in length.

Step-by-Step Instructions

STEP 1 Lay lace on top of the burlap ribbon. Thread the needle with floss and tie knot in end. Begin to sew a running stitch down the center through both layers (make stitches about ½") gathering as you sew. Continue this for the entire length and secure with knot.

STEP 2 Cut 1 yard pieces of the black ribbon and fold in half. Glue in place onto the back side of garland.

STEP 3 Tie onto railing, around doorways or mantle with craft wire.

- Offray Burly, 6", 1 Roll
- Offray Lacey, 6", 1 Roll
- Offray Double Face Satin, Black, 2 1/4", 10 Yards
- Boye Steel Darning Needle
- White Embroidery Floss
- Scissors
- Glue
- Craft Wire
- Straight Pins
