

How to Make a Candy Corn Banner



Brighten up your home, classroom, or office with this colorful DIY ribbon and fabric banner. Check out your local Walmart for the supplies needed to make this sweet fall decoration.

Step-by-Step Instructions

YOU WILL NEED

- Offray Single Face Satin Ribbon, 7/8 Inch, Lemon
- Offray Swiss Dot Grosgrain Ribbon, 7/8 Inch, Black
- Offray Random Puff Dot Grosgrain Ribbon, 7/8 Inch, Yellow
- Offray Bottle Cap Epoxy Stickers
- Springs Palencia Fabric, Black, White, and Orange
- HeatnBond, 7/8 and 17 Inch Wide
- Coats Black Thread
- Ruler or Measuring Tape

STEP 1 Using ruler, pencil, and paper, sketch out desired triangle size of candy corn for banner. Copy and cut out at least 3 times. Allow for 1/4 inch seam.

STEP 2 Cut one of the triangles where you would like to have each color start and finish.

STEP 3 Pin full triangles to white and black fabric and cut as many triangles as you would like for your banner. Pin middle piece to orange fabric and cut corresponding orange pieces.

STEP 4 Allowing for ribbon to be placed above orange fabric, attach orange fabric to white triangles using HeatnBond iron-on adhesive as per instructions on package.

STEP 5 Place polka dot and solid yellow ribbon above orange fabric. Adhere with 7/8 inch HeatnBond iron-on adhesive according to package directions.

STEP 6 Place white and black triangles front to front, with wrong side of fabric facing out. Pin and sew together. This will be the inside of the candy corn.

STEP 7 Turn each triangle right side out. Iron flat. Use pencil or scissor to help push through the pointed end.

STEP 8 Cut black fabric to length of the top of each triangle and approximately 3 inches wide. Attach iron-on adhesive to top of each piece of black fabric and attach front to back of each triangle.

Step-by-Step Instructions

STEP 9 Layer and space black polka dot ribbon as desired. Pin until you have appropriate placement. Once complete, sew or use no-sew adhesive to attach permanently to top of triangle candy corns.

STEP 10 Print out letters. We used FALL FUN. Using 1 inch circle punch, punch out letters and attach to inside of Bottle Cap Stickers. Cover with clear adhesive attachments included in the package. Adhere to banner with foam adhesive or glue gun.

STEP 11 Hang and enjoy!

YOU WILL NEED

- 1 Inch Circle Punch
- Pencil and Paper
- Scissors, Fabric and General
- Straight Pins And Needle
- Mat
- Iron and Ironing Board
- Optional: Sewing Machine, Glue Gun, Printer or Letter Stickers
