How to Make an Easy Ribbon Wreath



If you can tie a knot, you can create this fun wreath! Get a head start on decorating your home for any season with this easy DIY ribbon wreath. Mix and match ribbon colors, patterns, and widths to create a wreath design that is uniquely yours!

Step-by-Step Instructions



- STEP 1** To cover a 16 inch wreath form, you will need approximately 50 pieces of ribbon, about 7 pieces per style. Your own project will need less or more if you choose different widths of ribbon or if your wreath form is a different size. Each piece should be cut to approximately 15 inches; this should be enough length to wrap around, tie in a knot and have excess material.
- STEP 2** Choose a place to start. Wrap a piece of ribbon around the wreath form and tie a knot so the excess material is on the outside of the loop,
- STEP 3** Take one piece of each of the different ribbon designs to complete the pattern. Tie a knot in the same way as Step 2.
- STEP 4** Continue adding your pieces of ribbon until all of the wreath form is covered. You can add them in a pattern or mix it up.

YOU WILL NEED

- Offray Grosgrain Polka Dots Ribbon, 1.5 Inch Wide, Maize, Brown, and Torrid Orange - 3+ Yards of Each Color
- Offray Country Sunflower Floral Ribbon, 1.5 Inch Wide, Yellow - 3+ Yards
- Offray French Block Damask Pattern Ribbon, 7/8 Inch Wide, Brown - 3+ Yards
- Offray Maggie Ribbon, 1/2 Inch Wide, Yellow - 3+ Yards
- Offray Gazette Ribbon, 2 Inch Wide, Stone - 3+ Yards
- 16" Wreath Form
- Ruler or Measuring Tape
- Scissors
