How to Make A Ribbon Placemat



Create a festive and dainty placemat, perfect for fall decor and more!

Step-by-Step Instructions

YOU WILL NEED

- Offray, Shell Grey, 5/8", 4 yards
- Boye, Pom Pom Tassel Maker
- White Placemat
- White Yarn
- Thread
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Straight Pins
- Sewing Machine or Fabric Glue

STEP 1 Starting at the center of the bottom edge and working left, measure 1" from the lower edge and start to pin until 2" from the short edge.

STEP 2 Fold the ribbon upward. Measure 4 1/4" from the bottom edge and fold the ribbon to the right. Measure 4 1/4" from the short edge and fold the ribbon downward. Measure 2 1/2" from the lower edge and fold the ribbon to the left crossing over the ribbon creating a square. Measure 1 1/2" from the outer short edge folding the ribbon upward. Repeat step 2 on each remaining corner. Sew or glue into place.

STEP 3 Make four 1 1/2" pompoms following the manufacturer instructions. Trim each pompom to 1". Attach a pompom to each corner of the placemat.
