

Pumpkin Décor



Looking for an alternative to carving pumpkins this year? Decorate your pumpkins in festive fall ribbons for a fun and easy addition to your autumn decorations.

Step-by-Step Instructions

YOU WILL NEED

- 6 ft. of 1 ½" Offray Chevron Grosgrain Ribbon, Black
- 6 ft. of 5/8" Offray Olivia Ribbon, Orange
- 2 ft. of ¼" Offray Quasar Ribbons, Silver
- 3 ft. of 18" Offray Sparkle Tulle, Black
- 10 ft. of ½" Offray Maggie Ribbon, Black
- 2 ft. of 1 ½" Offray Grosgrain Ribbon, Torrid Orange
- 2 pumpkins – approximately 7"-8" tall or 24" diameter
- Glue Gun and Glue
- Pipe Cleaner
- Scissors
- Ruler

- STEP 1** Starting at the top of your first pumpkin, glue one 24-inch strip of 1 ½" black Chevron Grosgrain near the stem. Wrap the ribbon around the pumpkin to the opposite side of the stem and glue.
- STEP 2** Repeat Step 1 with a second 24-inch strip of 1 ½" black Chevron Grosgrain.
- Using 24-inches of 5/8" orange Olivia, glue one end at the stem of the pumpkin. Wrap the ribbon around the pumpkin to the opposite side of the stem and glue.
- STEP 3**
- STEP 4** Repeat Step 3 using a second 24-inch strip of 5/8" orange Olivia.
- STEP 5** Repeat this process to fill in the remaining space using 2 strips of 1/8" silver Quasar.
- STEP 6** Make a bow using the Chevron Grosgrain and Olivia. Secure with a pipe cleaner and wrap around the stem. Cut ends of excess pipe cleaner.
- STEP 7** Repeat Steps 1, 2 and 3 for the second pumpkin using 8 ft. of black Maggie.
- STEP 8** Place the pumpkin in the center of the black Offray Sparkle Tulle and gather at the top of the stem all the way around. Secure with a pipe cleaner.
- STEP 9** Repeat Step 6 using the remaining black Maggie and the orange Grosgrain.
